

Instructions – Cub Scout Camper Registration Form

1. Camp Session – Indicate which session your Scout will attend. Mark only **ONE** choice. If your Scout will attend both weeks of Day Camp, complete a separate form for each week.
2. Personal Information
 - Enter this Scout's Pack #, Name, and Birth Date.
 - Enter the address where paper mail should be sent to this camper's parents or guardians.
 - Next School Grade – Enter the school grade your Scout will enter in September 2012. Scouts are assigned to dens at Day Camp based on school grade and age as follows:
 Entering 1st Grade or Age 6: Tiger Entering 3rd Grade or Age 8: Bear
 Entering 2nd Grade or Age 7: Wolf Entering 4th/5th Grade or Age 9 or 10: Webelos *
 * All Webelos participate in the same program. The program changes each year. Webelos attending Day Camp for two years experience a different program each year.
 - Email Address: Enter an email address for this Scout's parent/guardian. Important information about Day Camp will be sent to this address, and email will be the primary method for communicating with Day Camp participants. Do not enter an email address for this Scout.
3. Shirt Size – Circle the shirt size that your Scout will wear at Day Camp.
4. Extra Shirts – Enter the number of **extra** camp shirts to purchase for your Scout. Extra shirts cost \$10 each. Each Scout receives one free camp shirt. Official Day Camp shirts **MUST** be worn every day at camp. They are color coded and used as Day Camp's primary security feature. Buy a spare to avoid washing a shirt every night.
5. Cost of Extra Shirts – Enter the total cost of extra shirts ordered. Extra shirts cost \$10 each.
6. Registration Fees – Day Camp costs \$135 per Scout. Discounts and adjustments for siblings and parent volunteers are shown in the list. Place a check mark on the appropriate line to indicate your registration fee.
NOTE: Each parent volunteer earns one discount for one Scout. One parent volunteer attending with two Scouts earns a discount for the first Scout but not for the second. The discount price of \$25 for the third and all subsequent Scouts from a single family applies with or without a parent volunteer.
7. Total Fee: Total the costs of the registration fee and extra shirts. Write the total on this line and submit payment as directed by your unit. If you are registering directly with the registrar, make your check payable to BAC/BSA. Registering as part of a unit is preferred.
8. Medical Form – Everyone attending Day Camp **MUST** submit a BSA Medical Form, parts A and B. A physical exam by a doctor is **NOT** required for Day Camp. Please complete a medical form and submit a copy with this registration. Registration forms submitted without a medical form will not be processed.
9. Insurance Card – The BSA Medical Form requests a copy of both sides of your medical insurance card. Please provide that with your registration. If you do not have medical insurance or are unwilling to provide insurance information, please write "No Insurance" on the medical form. This will prevent the registrar from attempting to contact you to request insurance information unnecessarily. Registration without insurance information IS allowed.
10. Authorized Adults – Only the parents/guardians and adults listed on this form will be allowed to leave camp with this Scout. If applicable, list the names of any adult(s) prohibited from dropping off or picking up a Scout from Day Camp. No child will be allowed to leave camp with an adult listed as "Prohibited" under any circumstances.
